Notes

CBC isolate supplied as a high-assay viscous fraction or crystalline lot depending on campaign. Intended for R&D and commercial formulation, not retail consumer packaging. CBC is thermally sensitive relative to CBD. Request the current physical form on the inquiry so packaging (amber vial vs. jar) matches the lot.

This sheet states the specification for the SKU. Measured values — identity method used, assay, other cannabinoids, residuals, appearance, water activity and origin — are reported per lot on the certificate of analysis that ships with the material. Destination jurisdiction is required on every inquiry; some materials (THCV and isomer-adjacent species) require review before shipment.
