Notes

CBDA isolate handled as a cold-chain-preferred acidic cannabinoid. For laboratories that need the carboxylated species rather than decarboxylated CBD. Decarboxylates with heat. Specify storage: 2–8 °C recommended after receipt. Do not assume CBD-equivalent handling.

This sheet states the specification for the SKU.
